ROADS AND HIGHWAYS MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

For the sole purpose of funding general operating expenses to be incurred in maintenance and repair of roads and highways within the County of Leelanau, at the same millage level previously approved by the voters every two years since 1986, shall the Constitutional limitation upon the total amount of taxes which may be assessed in one (1) year upon all property within the county of Leelanau, Michigan, be renewed at 0.5000 mill (\$0.5000 per \$1,000 of Taxable Value) for a period of two (2) years (2010-2011) inclusive?

(If approved and levied in full, this millage will raise an estimated \$1,189,916 for road and highway maintenance and repair general operating expenses in the first calendar year of the levy based on taxable value. In accordance with State law, the millage will be disbursed to the Leelanau County Road Commission, and the Villages of Empire, Northport, and Suttons Bay.)
