SUBJECT: Section 46 of the Michigan Campaign Finance Act

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 46 of the Michigan Campaign Finance Act, the following is provided:

- 1. An adjustment to the contribution limits specified in sections 52, 52a and 69(1). The adjustments are effective January 1, 2019 and for a period of 4 years.**
- 2. A review of the current threshold for reporting the occupation and employer information of a contributor. These figures are not legislative recommendations.**

With this memo the results of that review and adjustments are announced in accordance with the provisions of Section 46.

1. Contribution Limits Effective January 1, 2019

2. Occupation and Employer Threshold Review (This is not an adjustment.)
