	04/01-04/30:	Census Apportionment release of census data to determine number of Congressional seats per state	
	04/15:	Public hearing dates, times and locations confirmed; Pilot 1-2 hearings by 4/30	
May luga	Goals: Public hearings and initial mapping		
May — June Meeting Frequency: 2-5x week	05/01– 06/20:	Public hearings (at least ten)

	09/17 –10/31:	45-day period for public comments ends; Final vote on maps	
	10/16:	By this date must publish report with rationale for the proposed maps	
<b>November</b> Meeting Frequency: 1x week	<b>Goals:</b> Draft and approve final reports; other wrap-up work and begin work regarding possible litigation		
	11/01:	Final maps adopted by commission and published	
	Goals: Post-mortem and litigation		
<b>December</b> Meeting Frequency: 1x week	12/01:	By 12/1, must publish report with rationale for final maps	
	12/31:	Maps become law
