Step 1: Check your registration

Visit **Michigan.gov/Vote** to confirm your information and address is correct. This will make sure we send your ballot to the right address.



Step 2: Request your ballot early

Visit **Michigan.gov/Vote.** You can apply online to have your ballot sent to you, or find your local election clerk's office to apply in person. Then, wait for your ballot to arrive.



Step 3: Vote and return your ballot

Drop off your ballot at your local drop box or your local election clerk's office. Or, send it back through the mail.
