**An incumbent judge who wishes to seek reelection to the judicial position he or she currently holds can gain access to the ballot by filing an Affidavit of Candidacy and an Affidavit of Identity (in duplicate) no later than 5:00 p.m. on March 21, 2016. The withdrawal deadline elapses at 5:00 p.m. on March 24, 2016. \*\*An individual appointed to fill a vacancy should contact the Bureau of Elections for information regarding the applicable filing deadline.**
