**A non-incumbent Supreme Court candidate can gain access to the ballot by filing together the following:**

- Affidavit of Identity forms (two originals)
- Qualifying nominating petition forms bearing the requisite number of valid signatures

**Filing deadline: no later than 4:00 p.m. on July 19, 2018. The withdrawal deadline elapses at 4:00 p.m. on July 23, 2018**
