**AUGUST 4, 2015 ELECTION
CALENDAR OF DATES**

By April 28	Petitions to place proposals on ballot filed with county and local clerks. (If governing law sets an earlier petition filing deadline, earlier deadline must be observed.) (168.646a)
May 1	Last day a recall petition can be filed for August election. (Recalls filed against Governor, state-level or countywide office only. Does not apply to local offices; see May & November calendars for applicable deadlines.) (168.963)
By 4:00 p.m., May 12	Ballot wording of proposals qualified to appear on ballot certified to county and local clerks. (168.646a)
By June 20	Clerks shall electronically transmit or mail (as requested) an absent voter ballot to each absent UOCAVA (uniformed services or overseas) voter who applied for an absent voter ballot 45 days or more before the election (MOVE deadline.) (168.759a)
By June 20	Absent voter ballots must be available for issuance to voters. (168.714)
June 25 through July 14	Precinct inspectors appointed for election. (168.674)
By June 29	Notice of close of registration for election published. (168.498)
July 6	Last day to register for election. (168.497)
By July 24	Pre-election Campaign Statements filed (closes July 19).
By July 28	Notice of election published. (168.653a)
By July 30	Public accuracy test must be conducted by local election commission. (R 168.778) Notice of test must be published at least 48 hours before test. (168.798)
By 2:00 p.m., August 1	Electors who wish to receive an absent voter ballot for election by mail submit applications. (168.759)
By 4:00 p.m. August 3	Electors qualified to obtain an absent voter ballot for election may vote in person in clerk's office. (168.761)

Up to 4:00 p.m., August 4	Emergency absentee voting for election. (168.759b)
Aug. 4	ELECTION
Before 11:00 a.m., August 5	Local clerk delivers result of election to county clerk. (168.809)
By August 10	Boards of County Canvassers meet to canvass election. (168.821)
Sept. 3	Post-Election Campaign Statements filed (closes Aug. 24.)
