

A proposal to amend the Michigan Constitution by amending Article 4, Section 41 to authorize the establishment of eight new casinos at specific locations in the state, in addition to creating Michigan jobs, and economic development; to require the taxation of revenues generated by casinos and the dedication of these revenues to K-12 schools, police and fire services, and road repair and construction; to give voters in cities, townships and villages in which casinos are located the right to vote on whether they want casino gaming in their community; and by subjecting the casinos to the regulatory authority of the Michigan Gaming Control Board.

This proposal is to be voted on at the November 6, 2012 general election. For the full text of the proposed amendment and existing language of the Constitution to be altered or abrogated thereby, see the reverse side of this petition.

**INITIATIVE PETITION
AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION
A Proposal to Amend the Constitution of the State of Michigan
By Amending Article 4, Section 41 to Read as Follows:**

The proposal amends art 4 § 41 of the State Constitution. (New language capitalized. Language to be altered or abrogated struck through).

1. The Legislature may authorize lotteries and permit the sale of lottery tickets in any manner provided by law. No tax receipt after January 1, 2004, that authorizes any form of gambling shall be effective after January 1, 2004, shall any new state lottery game, including table games or pay-to-operate mechanical or electronic devices be established, whether the approval of a majority of electors voting in a statewide general election and a majority of electors voting in the township or city where the game will take place. This section shall not apply to gambling set up to three casinos in the City of Detroit or to Indian tribal gaming. IN ADDITION, FOR THE PURPOSE OF MICHIGAN EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AS WELL AS FUNDING FOR K-12 SCHOOLS, POLICE AND FIRE SERVICES, AND ROAD CONSTRUCTION AND REPAIR, CASINO GAMING SHALL BE PERMITTED IN THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS THROUGHOUT THE STATE OF MICHIGAN:

2. AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "CASINO GAMING" MEANS GAMBLING IN EACH AND ALL FORMS NOW AND HEREAFTER AUTHORIZED WITHIN THE STATE OF MICHIGAN AND BY FEDERAL LAW. THE TERM "CASINO" MEANS THE FACILITY IN WHICH ACTUAL GAMING ACTIVITIES ARE CONDUCTED.

3. THIS SECTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT ONLY IF ADOPTED BY A MAJORITY OF ELECTORS VOTING IN A STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION AND A MAJORITY OF ELECTORS VOTING IN THE TOWNSHIP, CITY OR VILLAGE WHERE GAMBLING WILL TAKE PLACE.

4. ALL CASINOS AUTHORIZED UNDER MICHIGAN LAW SHALL PAY A VAGUERING TAX ON THEIR ADJUSTED GROSS RECEIPTS IN THE AMOUNT OF 23%. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, ADJUSTED GROSS RECEIPTS MEANS GROSS RECEIPTS LESS WINNINGS PAID TO WAGGERS, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF CASINOS LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF DETROIT. REVENUES GENERATED BY THE WAGERING TAXES SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED AS FOLLOWS:

- A. 30% DIRECTLY TO K-12 PUBLIC SCHOOLS THROUGHOUT THE STATE OF MICHIGAN;
- B. 20% DIRECTLY TO ALL MUNICIPALITIES INCLUDING COUNTIES THROUGHOUT THE STATE TO FUND POLICE AND FIRE;
- C. 20% TO THE CITY, TOWNSHIP OR VILLAGE IN WHICH THE CASINO IS LOCATED;
- D. 20% TO THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE CASINO IS LOCATED;
- E. 5% TO THE STATE OF MICHIGAN TO FUND ROAD REPAIR AND CONSTRUCTION THROUGHOUT THE STATE; AND
- F. 5% TO THE STATE OF MICHIGAN TO FUND GAMBLING ADDICTION PREVENTION PROGRAMS THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

REVENUES GENERATED BY THE WAGERING TAX FROM CASINOS WITHIN THE CITY OF DETROIT SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED AS FOLLOWS:

- A. 60% TO POLICE AND FIRE SERVICES IN THE CITY OF DETROIT;
- B. 20% DIRECTLY TO FUND K-12 SCHOOLS THROUGHOUT THE STATE OF MICHIGAN; AND
- C. 20% TO THE STATE OF MICHIGAN TO FUND ROAD REPAIRS AND CONSTRUCTION THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

5. NO OTHER TAXES, FEES, ASSESSMENTS OR COSTS OF ANY KIND RELATED DIRECTLY TO GAMING OR WAGERING SHALL BE IMPOSED UPON A CASINO SUBJECT TO THE WAGERING TAX DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION, EXCEPT FOR REASONABLE REGULATORY FEES IMPOSED BY THE STATE OF MICHIGAN FOR A LICENSE TO OPERATE THE CASINO OR FOR FINES AND PENALTIES ASSESSED BY THE STATE OF MICHIGAN FOR CONDUCT PROHIBITED BY MICHIGAN LAW.

6. ALL OF THE CASINOS AUTHORIZED BY THIS SECTION SHALL BE GRANTED LIQUOR LICENSES ISSUED BY THE STATE OF MICHIGAN TO SERVE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON THE PREMISES.

7. CASINO GAMING REGULATED BY THIS SECTION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE EXCLUSIVE REGULATORY JURISDICTION OF THE MICHIGAN GAMING CONTROL BOARD OR ITS SUCCESSOR AGENCY. EACH CASINO, HOWEVER, SHALL BE SUBJECT TO APPLICABLE STATE AND LOCAL HEALTH AND BUILDING LAWS AND ORDINANCES PROVIDED THAT NEITHER THE STATE NOR ANY LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT MAY USE EXISTING OR FUTURE ZONING OR OTHER LAND USE LAWS TO IN ANY WAY HINDER OR BAR THE DEVELOPMENT, CONSTRUCTION OR OPERATION OF THE CASINOS AUTHORIZED BY THIS CONSTITUTIONAL PROVISION.

8. TO ENSURE TRANSPARENCY AND ACCOUNTABILITY, IT SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE MICHIGAN GAMING CONTROL BOARD OR ITS SUCCESSOR AGENCY TO PROVIDE ALL MICHIGAN CITIZENS WITH AN ANNUAL PUBLIC REPORT AS TO THE REVENUES GENERATED BY THE WAGERING TAX DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION 4 AND THE SPECIFIC AMOUNTS DELIVERED ANNUALLY TO:

- A. K-12 SCHOOLS THROUGHOUT THE STATE OF MICHIGAN;
- B. POLICE AND FIRE SERVICES THROUGHOUT THE STATE OF MICHIGAN;
- C. CITIES, TOWNSHIPS AND VILLAGES IN WHICH CASINOS ARE LOCATED;
- D. THE STATE OF MICHIGAN FOR ROAD REPAIR AND CONSTRUCTION; AND
- E. GAMBLING ADDICTION PREVENTION PROGRAMS THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

THE MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY SHALL PROVIDE WHATEVER ASSISTANCE IS REQUIRED BY THE MICHIGAN GAMING CONTROL BOARD RELATIVE TO THE COLLECTION OF DATA NECESSARY TO GENERATE THE ANNUAL REPORT REQUIRED BY THIS SUBSECTION AND THIS REPORT SHALL BE PUBLISHED ON A PUBLIC WEB SITE.

9. UPON ADOPTION OF THIS SECTION, THE MICHIGAN GAMING CONTROL BOARD OR ANY SUCCESSOR AGENCY MAY PROMULGATE RULES AND TAKE OTHER ACTIONS CONSISTENT WITH ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY NECESSARY TO LICENSE CASINOS AND CASINO RELATED ACTIVITIES AND TO OTHERWISE CARRY OUT THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

10. THE LEGISLATURE SHALL ENACT LAWS TO PROMOTE AND ENCOURAGE THE EMPLOYMENT OF MICHIGAN RESIDENTS AND THE USE OF EQUIPMENT MANUFACTURED IN MICHIGAN IN THE DEVELOPMENT AND OPERATION OF CASINOS IN THIS STATE.

11. THIS SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO NATIVE AMERICAN TRIBAL GAMING.

ALTERED OR ABROGATED LANGUAGE

Provisions of the Existing Constitution altered or abrogated by the proposal if adopted are as follows:

The Legislature may authorize lotteries and permit the sale of lottery tickets in any manner provided by law. No law enacted after January 1, 2004, that authorizes any form of gambling shall be effective, nor after January 1, 2004, shall any new state lottery games utilizing raffle games or player operated mechanical or electronic devices be established, without the approval of a majority of electors voting in a statewide general election and a majority of electors voting in the township or city where gambling will take place. This section shall not apply to gambling in up to three casinos in the City of Detroit or to Indian tribal gaming.
