CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

Pursuant to MCL §169.215(10) of the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (the Act), MCL §169.201 *et seq.*, the Secretary of State and Janet Dunn (Respondent) hereby enter into a conciliation agreement with respect to certain acts, omissions, methods, or practices prohibited by the Act.

The Secretary of State alleges that there may be reason to believe that Respondent violated MCL §169.257(1) by making improper expenditures by using township resources to fax campaign finance statements.

Therefore, Respondent, without admitting any issue of law or fact, except as stated herein, hereby voluntarily enters into this conciliation agreement and assures the Secretary of State that she will comply with the Act and the Rules promulgated to implement the Act.

By executing this conciliation agreement, Respondent certifies that a civil fine in the amount of \$100.00 has been paid to the State of Michigan.

The Secretary of State and Respondent further agree that this agreement is in effect and enforceable for four years from the date it is signed by the Secretary of State or her duly authorized representative.

The Secretary of State and Respondent further agree that this agreement, unless violated, shall constitute a complete bar to any further action by the Secretary of State with respect to the alleged violation that resulted in the execution of this agreement.

The Secretary of State and Respondent further agree that the complaint and investigation that resulted in this agreement are disposed of and will not be the basis for further proceedings, except pursuant to this agreement.

The Secretary of State and Respondent further agree that this agreement will not prevent the Secretary of State from taking action for violations of this agreement.

The Secretary of State and Respondent further agree that Respondent's performance under this agreement shall be given due consideration in any subsequent proceedings.

The Secretary of State and Respondent further agree that this agreement, when signed, shall become a part of the permanent public records of the Department of State.



A knowing violation of section 57 is a misdemeanor offense. MCL 169.257(4).

The Act also requires the Department to "endeavor to correct the violation or prevent a further violation by using informal methods [,]" if it finds that there may be reason to believe that a violation has occurred, and if the Department is unable to correct or prevent additional violations, it must ask the Attorney General to prosecute if a crime has been committed. MCL 169.215(10)(a). The objective of an informal resolution is "to correct the violation or prevent a further violation [,]" *Id.*

Mr. Corrado filed his complaint on June 8, 2017. You filed an answer on July 10, 2017, and Mr. Corrado filed a rebuttal statement on July 27, 2017.

Mr. Corrado alleged that you improperly used township resources to fax multiple campaign statements.

As evidence, Mr. Corrado provided a copy of your Amended Statement of Organization, your 2016 Post-General campaign statement, your Amended 2016 Post-General campaign statement, and the cover page from your second Amended 2016 Post-General campaign statement. At the top of each page is an imprint which reads "MACOMB TWP HMN RES [,]"

In your response you stated that your assistant, Cindy Paparelli, did "on a few occasions [utilize] a fax machine in the human resources office of Macomb Township to forward required campaign finance information to the proper department." You further stated that you did not specifically authorize the use of the township fax machine. You provided an affidavit from Ms. Paparelli, in which she asserted that she did use the township fax machine to file campaign finance


With his rebuttal statement, Mr. Corrado provided an additional 11 cover pages to your filed campaign finance statements, dating back to October 9, 2012. Each one of these cover pages includes an imprint with either reads “MACOMB TWP HMN RES” or “MACOMB TWP PKS REC [.]”

Because you admit that you requested that Ms. Paparelli, a township employee, fax your campaign finance statements during normal township business hours, and at least 15 of your statements over a period of at least 4 years have been filed using township fax machines, the Department concludes that the evidence supports a reason to believe that a violation of section 57 of the Act occurred. The Department notes that this was more than a 1-time oversight involving the faxing of 1 or 2 pages. Upon making this determination the Department is required by law to attempt to resolve the matter informally. MCL 169.215(10).

Based on the above, the Department offers to resolve this matter through execution of the enclosed conciliation agreement, which requires you to pay a civil fine to the State of Michigan in the amount of \$100.00.

If you wish to enter into the conciliation agreement, please return the original signed document to P.O. Box 20126, Lansing, Michigan 48901-0726, along with payment in full of the \$100.00 fine, on or before October 27, 2017. Payment must be made by check or money order payable to the State of Michigan; please include the notation, “Conciliation Agreement, Attn: Bureau of Elections” on your check or money order. A copy of the conciliation agreement signed by the Secretary of State’s authorized representative will be returned to you promptly. Please be advised that if the Department is unable to resolve the matter through informal methods, the Department must refer the matter to the Attorney General for enforcement of the criminal penalty provided in MCL 169.257(4). 

This letter concerns the complaint that was recently filed against you, which relates to a purported violation of the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (MCFA or Act), 1976 PA 388, MCL 169.201 *et seq.* The Department of State has received a rebuttal statement from the complainant, a copy of which is enclosed with this letter.

Section 15(10) of the MCFA, MCL 169.215(10), requires the Department to determine within 45 business days from the receipt of the rebuttal statement whether there is a reason to believe that a violation of the Act has occurred. Mr. Corrado's complaint remains under investigation at this time. At the conclusion of the review, all parties will receive written notice of the outcome of the complaint.


In rebuttal to the response file by Mrs. Janet Dunn on June 30, 2017 in regards to the alleged violation of the Michigan Campaign Finance Act, I have reviewed the statement of Mrs. Dunn and Mrs. Paparelli and would like to inform your office that this abuse has transpired well before Mrs. Paparelli (Employee#1606) was the Confidential Assistant of Mrs. Dunn.

In fact, every filing that Mrs. Dunn was required to make from November 2012 to present, she has used Macomb Township resources to file (17 violations). The attached evidence is overwhelming. You will see that the timestamps do not correlate to the statements of Mrs. Dunn and Mrs. Paparelli as there are submissions well outside of any standard lunch hour. Furthermore, this is a violation of MCL 15.404 Section 4.

This is not the first time that Mrs. Dunn has been in violation of Election Laws. It is notable that Mrs. Dun was found guilty of Election Fraud in August of 2013. While she was on probation for election fraud, Mrs. Dunn continued to show disregard for the law by using tax payer resources to violate election law and file documents with the County Clerk on behalf of her Political Action Committee. (Exhibit 1)

This lack of regard for public resources and trust is unacceptable behavior for a public servant. I hope that your department will conduct a thorough investigation and put an end to the corrupt actions of the Macomb Township Supervisor.
