

Vendors Authorized to Perform Electronic and Remote Notarizations in Michigan

July 2020

The Michigan Law on Notarial Acts requires the Department of State in conjunction with the Department of Technology, Management and Budget to approve vendors that will be authorized to perform electronic/remote notarial acts. Only approved vendor systems can be used to perform an electronic/remote notarization.

The approvals are effective immediately and Notaries can contract with their selected vendor, which will require a fee. Links to each vendor are provided below for you to begin your research should you choose to purchase any or all of these systems. Their use is optional, and no action is needed on your part to continue performing traditional pen and paper notarizations. **All questions related to system capabilities, cost, training, etc, must be directed to the vendors themselves.**
