IDENTITY DOCUMENTS FOR A DUPLICATE DRIVER LICENSE OR PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CARD

(Not an all-inclusive list.)

PHOTOCOPIES OR FAX COPIES OF DOCUMENTS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE

Every person who applies for a duplicate (replacement) driver license or personal identification card must present acceptable identification documents. All identification documents presented are subject to approval by Department of State personnel. When necessary, additional identification documents may be required.

The following documents may be used to establish identity when applying for a duplicate driver license or personal identification card:

- Bank statements (no receipts)
- Court records
- Department of Human Services documents
- Expired or previous Michigan driver license or PID
- Gun permit
- IRS or State income tax forms (no W-2s may be used)
- Life, homeowners, or rental insurance policies
- Medical records from a physician's office or hospital
- Merchant Marine ID
- Michigan voter registration card
- Mortgage or lease contract (payment booklets)
- Parent or legal guardian affidavit for a minor child
- Pilot's license
- Prison release documents
- Professional license (medical, real estate, etc.)
- School diplomas (no GED certificates)
- SSI eligibility documents
- Student loan documents
- U.S. military discharge or separation documents (DD-214, etc.)

Note: Applicants may also use documents listed on the SOS-428 Applying For A License or ID.
