The Public has the right to address the Commission and the Commission welcomes the Public's comments. The Public may do so in two different ways: (1) written comments which will be entered into the permanent public record for the meeting; and (2) speaking live to the Commission.

Both written comments and requests to speak must be submitted via a sign-up form which will be posted at [@RedistrictingMI](#) on [Facebook](#) and [Twitter](#) 24 hours prior to each day of public comment. In other words, the public comment form for Thursday, Sept. 17 will be posted on Wednesday, Sept. 16. The public comment form for Friday, Sept. 18 will be posted on Thursday, Sept. 17. Individuals who wish to address the Commission live will be invited to speak virtually on a first-come, first-served basis (based on the sign-up form). Each person who chooses to speak live will have up to 90 seconds to address the Commission. These individuals can expect to receive information about how to log-on to the webinar via the email they provide in the sign-up form.
