You may use this form to prevent your voter registration from being cancelled. Your voter registration may be cancelled if:

- (1) Before the November 2018 election, you surrendered your Michigan driver's license in another state, or election mail sent to you was returned to an election official as undeliverable;
- (2) Before the November 2018 election, you were sent a registration confirmation notice and did not respond to the notice; **and**
- (3) You did not vote or confirm your eligibility by the November 2020 election.

Note: Unless all three of these apply to you, your registration will <u>not</u> be cancelled and you don't need to use this form. If you have moved to a different address in Michigan, you can update your voter registration at <u>Michigan.gov/Vote</u>. You can request the list of voters who will be cancelled in 2021 by emailing <u>ElectionData@Michigan.gov</u>.

To prevent your voter registration from being cancelled, return this form to your city or township clerk. You can find your clerk's contact information by going to Michigan.gov/Vote and clicking on "Your Clerk."

You can return this form in any of the following ways:

- 1. **Mail it.** Make sure the envelope has proper postage and is addressed to your local clerk
- 2. **E-mail it.** Take a picture of the form (or scan it) and e-mail it to your clerk. Make sure your signature is visible.
- 3. **Deliver it in person** to the clerk, the clerk's office, or the clerk's authorized assistant.
