**REVIEW OF NOMINATING PETITION**

**NUMBER OF VALID SIGNATURES REQUIRED:** 1,000 signatures.

**TOTAL FILING:** 1,183 signatures.

**RESULT OF FACE REVIEW:** 1,013 valid signatures; 170 invalid signatures.

**TOTAL NUMBER OF SIGNATURES QUESTIONED UNDER CHALLENGE:** Kirby McCoy and Aimee McKeever filed two separate challenges to Mr. Haberman’s nominating petition, challenging 362 and 278 signatures respectively, for a total of 640 signatures (note, many of these challenges overlapped one another).

**ANALYSIS OF CHALLENGE/RESPONSE:** After processing both challenges and Mr. Haberman’s response, 69 additional signatures were determined to be invalid.

**FINAL RESULT:** 944 valid signatures.
