REVIEW OF NOMINATING PETITION

Patrick Bagley Candidate for Judge of the 51st District Court Regular Term, Incumbent Position

NUMBER OF VALID SIGNATURES REQUIRED: 100 signatures.¹

TOTAL FILING: 56 signatures.

<u>RESULT OF FACE REVIEW</u>: The maximum number of potentially valid signatures is only 28% of the minimum number required by statute, and 56% of the minimum number required by the May 20, 2020 court order in *Esshaki v Whitmer*.

CHALLENGE: None.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Determine petition insufficient.

¹ Pursuant to MCL 168.544f, candidates seeking this office must submit a minimum of 200 valid signatures to qualify for placement on the ballot. Mr. Bagley qualifies for a 50% reduction in the number of required signatures pursuant to the May 20, 2020 order of the federal District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan in *Esshaki v Whitmer*, <u>https://www.michigan.gov/documents/sos/64_order_grnt_PI_mtn_intervene_691388_7.pdf</u>.
