Computing Weight Fees Not Shown on the Charts

- 1. Determine the empty vehicle weight. Round the weight to the next lower hundred pounds when it ends in 50 pounds or less and to the next higher hundred pounds when it ends in 51 pounds or more. (10,150 lbs. is reduced to 10,100 lbs., while 10,151 lbs. becomes 10,200 lbs.).
- 2. Divide the rounded weight by 100. Then multiply the result by the fee per hundred pounds. Using the chart above, multiply the divided weight by 90¢ (x .90). Round this amount to the next lower whole dollar when it ends in 50¢ or less and round to the next higher whole dollar when it ends in 51¢ or more. **This amount is the 12-month weight fee.** (If the fee is not prorated, go to step 4.)
- 3. If the fee is to be prorated, determine the number of prorated months using the chart in Appendix B.
 - a) Divide the **12-month weight fee** as determined in step 2 by 12. Do not round. This is the **fee per month.**
 - b) Multiply the **fee per month** by the number of prorated months.
 - c) Round this amount as described in step 2.
- 4. As a final step for all weight fees, **add \$8** to the prorated fee as determined in step three; or if the fee is not prorated, **add \$8** to the 12-month weight fee as determined in step 2.
