

## **Major improvements to Project Management Methodology (PMM) forms are now available!**

- Reduced the number of PMM forms from 22 to just 4 by consolidation, elimination, and automation
- Eliminated redundancy among the forms
- Simplified wording
- Created boilerplate language for some sections
- Updated SUITE Overview Diagrams
- Relied on the Project Management Body of Knowledge (PMBOK) and industry best practices as the foundation for all new forms
- Iterative reviews by PMO Directors and certified Project Managers
- Includes feedback from Agile practitioners

Project Managers may begin using the new forms on their next project. For in-flight projects, Project Managers may continue to use the old forms or convert to the new ones at their discretion. Note that the old forms will be removed from both internet and intranet sites on June 30, 2013.
