Dear Mr. Chris Baranick:

Pursuant to Section 9f of Public Act (PA) 206 of 1893, as amended, the Department of Treasury received the New Personal Property Exemption resolution submitted for International Automotive Components Group North America, Inc., located at 27777 Franklin Road, #2000, in the City of Southfield, Oakland County.

As provided by Section 9f(3) of PA 206 of 1893, as amended, with the receipt of a written concurrence from the President of the Michigan Strategic Fund, the State Treasurer has determined that exempting the new personal property for this project is necessary to reduce unemployment, promote economic growth, and increase capital investment in the State of Michigan. Therefore, the New Personal Property Exemption Certificate #501-2020 is approved and is being issued for a period of 5 years. This certificate exempts from the collection of taxes under this Act, all new personal property purchased or leased by International Automotive Components Group North America, Inc., 27777 Franklin Road, #2000, beginning October 19, 2020 until December 30, 2025.

A party aggrieved by the issuance, refusal to issue, revocation, transfer or modification of an exemption may appeal a final decision by filing a petition with the Michigan Tax Tribunal, www.michigan.gov/taxtrib, within 35 days. MCL 205.735a (6).
