WHEREAS, the Board of Education has examined the financial circumstances of the Educational Service District for the 2019-2020 fiscal year, including estimated expenditures, estimated revenues, and state equalization valuation of property located within the district and has determined that the levy of 0.2121 mills for General Fund, 0.6371 mills for Special Education, and 0.65 mills for Vocational Education (CTE) will be necessary for the sound management and operation of the Educational Service District; and

WHEREAS, THE Board of Education has complete authority to establish a maximum tax rate of 0.2121 mills for General Fund, 0.6371 mills for Special Education, and 0.65 mills for Vocational Education (CTE) for operating purposes in 2019 from within its authorized millage rate;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. For 2019, the total millage rate of 0.2121 mills for General Fund, 0.6371 mills for Special Education, and 0.65 mills for Vocational Education (CTE) shall be levied upon taxable property located within the Educational Service District.
2. All resolutions and parts of resolutions insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution be and the same are hereby rescinded.
