Pursuant to Section 9f of Public Act (PA) 206 of 1893, as amended, the Department of Treasury received the New Personal Property Exemption resolution submitted for Internation Business Machines Corpotation, located at 600 Crescent Street, in the City of East Lansing, Ingham County.

As provided by Section 9f(3) of PA 206 of 1893, as amended, with the receipt of a written concurrence from the President of the Michigan Strategic Fund, the State Treasurer has determined that exempting the new personal property for this project is necessary to reduce unemployment, promote economic growth, and increase capital investment in the State of Michigan. Therefore, the New Personal Property Exemption Certificate #470-2015 is approved and is being issued for a period of 5 years. This certificate exempts from the collection of taxes under this Act, all new personal property purchased or leased by Internation Business Machines Corpotation, 600 Crescent Street, beginning April 21, 2015 until December 30, 2020.
