In accordance with Public Act 146 of 2000, as amended, the State Tax Commission (Commission), at their September 22, 2015 meeting, considered your application numbered 3-15-0012, for an obsolete property rehabilitation exemption certificate for the property located at 581 N Water Street, City of Vassar, Tuscola County.

The Commission denied the application. The denial was based on the fact that the company manufactures food products. Manufacturers do not meet the definition of a commercial business enterpriser per MCL 125.2782.
