Dear Ms. Nancy Tellem:

Pursuant to the requirements of Public Act (PA) 255 of 1978, as amended, the City of Detroit approved Commercial Facilities Exemption Certificate number 4-20-006, for Tellevation II LLC, 110 E Ferry Street, in the City of Detroit, Wayne County at a meeting held on June 2, 2020. The exemption has been approved for 12 years.

Your application indicates that you would like to be considered for a reduction of mills levied under the State Education Tax Act. The State Treasurer has the authority to grant an additional exclusion of up to one-half of the mills levied for the State Education Tax (3 mills) for new and replacement facilities. I regret to inform you that your request for the reduction of mills levied under the State Education Act, as provided in MCL 207.662a, has been denied as restored certificates are not eligible for the exclusion.
