Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate

New Certificate No. 2015-072

Pursuant to the provisions of Public Act 198 of 1974, as amended, the State Tax Commission hereby finds that the industrial property, as described in the approved application, hereafter referred to as the industrial facility, owned or leased by MP Acquisition, LLC, and located at 21750 Coolidge Highway, City of Oak Park, County of Oakland, Michigan, within a Plant Rehabilitation or Industrial Development District, is intended for the construction or installation of new industrial property, and complies with Section 9 and other provisions of the act.

Therefore, as provided by MCL 207.551 to 207.572, inclusive, the State Tax Commission hereby certifies the industrial facility as a **new industrial facility**.


