Dear Tax Tribunal Practitioner:

Consent Judgments

As you are aware, the Tribunal has moved to a “paperless” system for 2017 ET appeals, with small claims appeals to be “paperless” beginning in 2018. Further, as files are closed for 2016 and prior appeals, these files will be uploaded to the Tribunal’s docket look-up and paper files will be destroyed.

Given this move to a “paperless” Tribunal, effective immediately, the Tribunal will no longer be attaching parties’ Stipulations for Entry of Consent Judgment to the Consent Judgment. We have revised our Consent Judgments to mirror our other Orders and they will also include the following language: “**See docket look-up for a copy of stipulation and for any possible refund paragraph.**”

Therefore, parties to the appeals, as well as County Treasurers, will need to go to docket look-up to view the terms of a stipulation filed by the parties.
