One stop access for MiWAM and PMTC



On November 18, the Michigan Web Account Manager (MiWAM) and Pure Michigan Talent Connect (PMTc) systems are coming together to better serve you.

MILogin is the new State of Michigan Identity, Credential and Access Management solution. The MILogin solution will provide enhanced single sign-on capabilities in addition to meeting many other business requirements and security and compliance needs.

MILogin for Citizens will help you get back to work faster by allowing you to access your MiWAM unemployment insurance account and your PMTC jobseeker account in one place.

The new process is:

- Convenient—use one login for both MiWAM and PMTC accounts.
- Efficient—review your unemployment benefit status and see job listings based on your PMTC profile, all on one screen.
- Secure—single sign-on process provides an extra layer of security and helps prevent identity theft.
