 Contract (2000-0271) between MDOT and the Chippewa County Economic Development Corporation provides State Grant funds for Aircraft Rescue Fire Fighting (ARFF) Training available through the Kellogg Community College using the mobile fire training unit at Chippewa County International Airport in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan. The contract will be in effect for a period of 18 months from the date of award. Source of Funds: State Aeronautics Funds: \$4,000; Local Funds: \$1,500; Total Funds: \$5,500.

20. \*AERONAUTICS - Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting Training  
 Contract (2000-0339) between MDOT and the Oakland County Board of Commissioners to provide State grant funds for Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting (ARFF) Training at Oakland County International Airport in Pontiac, Michigan. The contract will be in effect for a period of 18 months from the date of award. Source of Funds: State Aeronautics Funds- \$4,000; Oakland County Funds - \$1,500; Contract total - \$5,500.

21. AERONAUTICS - Construction and Design Engineering  
 Contract (2000-0425) between MDOT and the Marquette County Board of Commissioners to provide Federal and State grant funds for the to construct North Entrance Road (2.9 miles by 24 feet) at Sawyer International Airport in Gwinn, Michigan. Federal funds will be made available through a grant from the FAA. The contract will be in effect for a period of 36 months from the date of award. Source of Funds: Federal Funds - \$1,719,000; State Aeronautics Funds - \$95,500; Marquette County Funds - \$95,500; Contract total - \$1,910,000.

22. AERONAUTICS - Weather Observation and Data Dissemination System  
Contract (2000-0426) between MDOT and the City of Charlevoix providing for the installation, operation, and maintenance of a "Weather Observation and Data Dissemination" system, furnished at Charlevoix Municipal Airport, Charlevoix, Michigan, in order to enhance aviation safety and efficiency. The term of this contract will begin upon award and the contract will be in effect for 15 years. The City of Charlevoix will pay MDOT ten percent (10%) share of the initial purchase and installation charges (estimated to be \$11,000.00) upon being invoiced by MDOT. Payment by the City of Charlevoix will be either cash or in kind credit for services paid by the City during the installation of the Automated Weather Observation System. The City of Charlevoix will pay MDOT fifty percent (50%) share of the cost to operate and maintain the Weather Observation and Data Dissemination System upon being invoiced by MDOT. The payment to MDOT by the City of Charlevoix is estimated at \$4,350 per year.
23. AERONAUTICS - Construct Terminal Building  
Contract (2000-0430) between MDOT and the City of Big Rapids to provide State grant funds for the construction of a general aviation terminal building at Roben-Hood Airport in Big Rapids, Michigan. The contract will be in effect for a period of 36 months from the date of award. Source of Funds: State Aeronautics Funds- \$75,000; City of Big Rapids Funds - \$75,000; Contract total - \$150,000.
24. AERONAUTICS - Rehabilitation of Runway  
Contract (2000-0434) between MDOT, the City of Gladwin, and the Gladwin County Board of Commissioners to provide Federal and State Grant funds for the rehabilitation of Runway 9/27, Taxiway, and Apron, including consultant construction supervision, at the Gladwin Zettel Memorial Airport in Gladwin, Michigan. This is a sub-grant issued pursuant to the condition of the Block Grant given to MDOT by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). The contract will be in effect for a period of 36 months from the date of award. Source of Funds: Federal Funds (via Block Grant): \$396,000; State Aeronautics Funds: \$22,000; City of Gladwin and Gladwin County Funds: \$22,000; Total Contract: \$440,000.
25. AERONAUTICS - Rehabilitation of Runway  
Contract (2000-0435) between MDOT and the City of Greenville to provide Federal and State Grant funds for rehabilitation of Runway 9/27, including consultant construction supervision, at the Greenville Municipal Airport in Greenville, Michigan. This is a sub-grant issued pursuant to the condition of the Block Grant given to MDOT by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). The contract will be in effect for a period of 36 months from the date of award. Source of Funds: Federal Funds (via Block Grant): \$396,000; State Aeronautics Funds: \$22,000; City of Greenville Funds: \$22,000; Total Contract: \$440,000.
26. \*CONSTRUCTION & TECHNOLOGY - Novation, Renewal, and Time Extension  
Amendatory contract (98-0443/A2) between MDOT, Tetra Tech MPS, and McNamee, Porter & Seeley, Inc., will transfer Contract responsibility from McNamee, Porter & Seeley, Inc., to Tetra Tech MPS, and will renew and extend the contract to add four months to the Contract

term. The contract provided construction engineering and services on I-94 in Jackson and Washtenaw Counties. This amendment will begin on amendment award and expire on August 31, 2000. Source of funds are 80% Federal and 20% State.

27. CONSTRUCTION AND TECHNOLOGY - Novation and Time Extension

Amendatory contract (98-0511/A1) between MDOT and Tetra Tech MPS (TTMPS) (previously McNamee, Porter & Seeley, Inc.), which provided construction engineering services on I-96 from the East Ingham County Line to M-59 in Livingston County. The time extension is for a period of 6 months, extending the contract through December 31, 2000, to allow for completion of the project. Source of funds are 80% Federal and 20% State.

28. CONSTRUCTION & TECHNOLOGY - Construction Engineering Services

Contract (99-0198) between MDOT and Wade-Trim Associates, Inc., provides for Construction Engineering and/or Inspection and Testing Services performed on an as needed/when needed basis for MDOT construction projects. This authorization (Z5, Revision 3) provides for additional construction engineering services for US-27 BR from US-27 through the city of Harrison to Townline Lake Road, CS/JN 18041/37970A. The original authorization is for the amount of \$341,829.54 and was on the April 20, 1999, State Administrative Board. The amount of this revision is \$24,571.29, bringing the total amount of the authorization to \$366,400.75. In addition, the anticipated completion date has been changed to October 30, 2000. Source of funds is 80% Federal and 20% State.

29. CONSTRUCTION & TECHNOLOGY - Construction Engineering Services

Contract (99-0205) between MDOT and Soils & Materials Engineers, Inc., provides for Construction Engineering and/or Inspection and Testing Services performed on an as needed/when needed basis for MDOT construction projects. Authorization Z1, Revision 2, provides for additional construction engineering services on the US-131 S-Curve in Grand Rapids, Kent County, CS/JN 41131/47169A. The original authorization was approved by the State Administrative Board on January 18, 2000, for the amount of \$139,631.74. Revision 1 was approved by the State Administrative Board on April 4, 2000, for the amount of \$123,834.15, bringing the total amount to \$263,221.01. This revision (Z1,R2) is for the amount of \$231,535.30, bringing the total amount of the authorization to \$494,756.31. The anticipated completion date is May 31, 2001. Source of funds is 80% Federal and 20% State.

30. CONSTRUCTION & TECHNOLOGY - Construction Engineering Services  
Contract (99-0216) between MDOT and Moore & Bruggink, Inc., provides for Construction Engineering and/or Inspection and Testing Services performed on an as needed/when needed basis for MDOT construction projects. This authorization (Z4) provides for construction engineering services on M-37 over Kraft Avenue in the Kent County, CS/JN 41031/34643A. The original authorization was approved by the State Administrative Board on March 7, 2000, for the amount of \$526,344.48. This revision (Z4,R1) is for the amount of \$463,656.00 and is due to construction costs being twice the amount of the engineers' estimate, bringing the total to \$990,000.48. The anticipated completion date is May 31, 2001. Source of funds is 80% Federal and 20% State.
31. \*DESIGN - Increase Costs and Extend Term  
Amendatory contract (90-2122/A7) between MDOT and Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc, which provides for design services during the construction of the plaza at the west end of the Blue Water Bridge/CS 77111 - JN's 20425A, 23084A, 23085A, 23086A & 31280A. The purpose of this amendment is to increase the contract amount by \$15,008.42 to allow for claim resolution and to extend the contract expiration date by 1 year. The revised contract amount is \$1,841,796.42. The revised contract expiration date is December 31, 2001.
32. DESIGN - Design Consultant Services  
Contract (2000-0003) between MDOT and H.W. Lochner, Inc., provides for design consultant services on an as needed/when needed basis. This contract, which was awarded on October 26, 1999, enables MDOT to initiate design activities with authorizations. The limit on these authorizations is \$400,000. Authorizations in excess of \$100,000 require the approval of the State Administrative Board. The term of this contract is from October 26, 1999, through October 26, 2002.

This authorization (Z1) is for \$375,000, which provides for the design of M-60 BR from Thirteenth Street to Bailey Avenue/CS 11041, 14061 - JN 45637C in Berrien and Cass counties. This is a pavement reconstruction and joint repair/overlay project and consists of the following work items: surveying, acquisition and review of videotape coverage of existing storm sewer system, and providing recommendations for reconstruction of sewer system, drainage study and related design, maintenance of traffic, ROW plans, and pavement marking/signing plans. The source of these funds is 81.85% FHWA and 18.15% State Trunkline funds.

33. DESIGN- Design Consultant Services  
Contract (2000-0342) between MDOT and URS Corporation Great Lakes, providing for the design of M-53, from 27.5 Mile Road to 34 Mile Rd. in the county of Macomb. This work includes, but is not limited to, the Early Preliminary Engineering (EPE) related to the development and evaluation of geometrics of the interchange at 32 Mile Road and traffic analysis for the M-53/Romeo Bypass project and designing the project, including, but not limited to, the construction of the northbound alignment and interchanges at Van Dyke Road and 32 Mile Road. The length of this project is 11.9 kilometers (7.4 miles). The term of this contract is from award and continues until December 31, 2002. The maximum dollar amount of this contract is \$3,600,000.00, 81.85%FHWA and 18.15% State Trunkline.
34. TRAFFIC & SAFETY - Consultant Services  
Contract (98-0019) between MDOT and Consoer Townsend Envirodyne Engineers provides for professional services on an as needed/when needed basis. This contract, which was awarded March 24, 1998, enables MDOT to initiate design and other related work necessary on Traffic & Safety projects with authorizations.
- This authorization (Z3) is for \$162,545, which provides for traffic signal design plans at 26 locations on M-102 (8 Mile Road) from M-5 (Grand River Ave.) to Northland Dr./Asbury Park in Wayne County. This authorization has an anticipated completion date of October 10, 2000. Source of funds is 100% State funded.
35. TRAFFIC & SAFETY - Consultant Services  
Contract (98-0021) between MDOT and Finkbeiner, Pettis and Strout, Inc., provides for professional services on an as needed/ when needed basis. This contract, which was awarded February 20, 1998, enables MDOT to initiate design and other related work necessary on Traffic & Safety projects with authorizations.
- This authorization (Z1) is for \$147,319, which provides for traffic signal design plans at 10 locations on BL-94, US-23BR (Washtenaw) from S. University to US-23 in Washtenaw County. This authorization has an anticipated completion date of September 1, 2000. Source of funds is 100% State funded.
36. TRAFFIC & SAFETY - Consultant Services  
Contract (98-0024) between MDOT and H.W. Lochner, Inc., provides for professional services on an as needed/when needed basis. This contract, which was awarded March 24, 1998, enables MDOT to initiate design and other related work necessary on Traffic & Safety projects with authorizations.
- This authorization (Z3) is for \$231,590, which provides for traffic signal design plans at 17 locations on BL-94, M-25 (Pine Grove) from Stone/Thomas to Meijer's Dr. in St. Clair County. This authorization has an anticipated completion date of December 1, 2000. Source of funds is 100 % State funded.
37. TRAFFIC & SAFETY - Consultant Services  
Contract (98-0029) between MDOT and TransCore ITS, Inc., (formerly SAIC) provides for professional services on an as needed/when needed basis. This contract, which was awarded March 27, 1998, enables MDOT to initiate design and other related work necessary on Traffic & Safety projects with authorizations.

This authorization (Z1) is for \$210,130, which provides for upgrading and rehabilitation of freeway signing on I-94 from Wyoming to M-102 (8 Mile Road) in Wayne County, and was approved by the State Administrative Board on July 7, 1998. The authorization was issued on July 8, 1998, with an expiration date of August 30, 1999. A time extension (Z1, Revision 1) was subsequently issued to extend the term to October 31, 1999. A time extension (Z1, Revision 2) was subsequently issued to extend the term to December 31, 1999. A time extension (Z1, Revision 3) was subsequently issued to extend the term to June 30, 2000. An increase of \$26,408 (Z1, Revision 4) was subsequently issued. This authorization (Z1, Revision 5) is for an extension of time only and would begin July 1, 2000 and expire on October 6, 2000. Source of funds is 100% State funded.

38. TRAFFIC & SAFETY - Consultant Services

Contract (98-0031) between MDOT and Wade Trim/Associates, Inc., provides for professional services on an as needed/when needed basis. This contract which was awarded February 11, 1998, enables MDOT to initiate design and other related work necessary on Traffic & Safety projects with authorizations.

This authorization (Z2) is for \$102,549, which provides for upgrading and rehabilitation of freeway signing on I-75 from I-275 to Sibley Road in Monroe and Wayne Counties, and was approved by the State Ad Board on June 1, 1999. The authorization was issued on June 3, 1999, with an expiration date of July 1, 2000. A revision (Z2, Revision 1) was subsequently issued to change the makeup of the line items that did not change the term of July 1, 2000. This authorization (Z2, Revision 2) is for an extension of time only and would begin July 2, 2000 and expire on December 15, 2000. Source of funds is 100% State funded.

39. \*TRANSPORTATION PLANNING - Novate, Extend Time, and Increase Budget
