INCOME, INCOME TAX, AND PROPERTY TAX CREDIT DATA BY SCHOOL DISTRICT, 1985

This report presents data from 1985 Michigan income tax returns tabulated by school district. This tabulation is based upon the school district code entered by taxpayers on individual income tax returns.

The basic income tax data are reported in Table 2, entitled "1985 Income and Net Tax Paid by School District," and Table 3, entitled "1985 Property Tax Credit by School District." The data presented in Table 2 are federal adjusted gross income (AGI), Michigan taxable income (AGI after adjustments and minus personal exemptions), household income used for property tax credit computations, and net tax paid, that is tax liability net of credits. Table 3 presents data for the number and amount of the several categories of property tax credits for each school district. Table 1 combines the information in Table 2 and Table 3 to provide summary statistics on income, income tax, and property tax credits. These summary statistics include average AGI, average tax paid both before and after credits, the ratio of property tax credits claimed (including farmland preservation credits) to income tax returns filed and, for those taxpayers receiving one, average property tax credit and average homestead property tax credit (excluding farmland credits).

The statistics in this report should be interpreted with some caution for several reasons. First, not all income tax returns are represented in this tabulation since 16.0% of total returns and 12.3% of property tax credit claims listed no school district code or a nonexistent code. These returns were excluded. Second, some taxpayers may have mistakenly listed an incorrect school district code. For example, the Bloomfield Hills School District is in Oakland County, while Bloomfield District #1 and Bloomfield Township Districts #4 and #7F are in Huron County. To the extent taxpayers miscategorized themselves, the data in those districts are incorrect. The third reason for caution is that as always, averages may give a misleading picture in some instances.

A \$300 average property tax credit for a certain school district, for example, may result from everyone in the district receiving about a \$300 credit or from many small credits and a few very large ones. The average property tax credit (or the average of any other fiscal variable in the study) for a district tells nothing about the distribution of those credits (or other variables) among taxpayers within the district. Also note that in Table 1 average income tax before and after credits are calculated using the number of returns with positive taxable income. These two averages for counties, included in the 1985 income tax report, are calculated using the number of returns with positive AGI, and thus are not compatible with the school district averages.

#### How to Read Table 1

School districts are grouped by county in this table. After each fiscal variable, the district's ranking relative to all districts for that variable is given. A ranking of 1 is given the highest average or ratio. A ranking of 574 is given the lowest average or ratio.

For example, the Alcona School District had an average AGI of \$16,279 in 1985, with a ranking of 509 out of 574 school districts. The average tax after credits was \$467. The number of property tax credits was 45.8% of the number of income tax returns filed, with an average property tax credit of \$334, ranking 456th among school districts. The average homestead property tax credit, excluding farmland credits, was \$318, ranking 458th.

#### How to Read Table 2

School Districts are again grouped by county in this table. In the Alcona district, for example, 1,957 returns had nonnegative AGI totaling \$31.9 million and 1,613 returns had nonnegative taxable income (after adjustments and exemptions) totaling \$21.1 million, and 902 returns reported household income (used in computing homestead property tax credits) totaling \$10.9 million. The total net income tax paid after all credits was \$753,413. The number of returns reported in each class is a count of returns with nonnegative values.
