SUBJECT: Public Health Code Fees Annual Adjustments for Change in Detroit CPI

Three sections of the Public Health Code require for fee changes based on amounts determined by the State Treasurer to reflect annual percent changes in the Detroit CPI. [The sections are: 333.5431(4), 333.13306(4), and 333.13522(8)]. In addition, MCL 289.3119(6) of the Food Law uses the June-June percentage change in the Detroit CPI for adjusting fees.

The percentage change from June 2014 to June 2015 in the Detroit All-Items CPI-U is -2.4 percent.

Newborn Screening Fee

As stipulated in **MCL 333.5431(4)**: To reflect the -2.4 percent decrease in the Detroit CPI between June 2014 and June 2015, the newborn screening fee may be decreased by no more than \$3.01 from \$125.36 to \$122.35 on October 1, 2015. Please note that the newborn screening fee may be increased as recommended by the Newborn Screening Quality Advisory Committee and approved by the legislature to cover the cost of new screening requirements.

In addition, as provided under MCL 333.5430, the fee may also be adjusted to account for changes in conditions covered and screening procedures as recommended by the newborn screening quality assurance advisory committee subject to the approval of the Department of Community Health and the legislature.

Dry Cleaning License Fees

As stipulated under **MCL 333.13306**, dry cleaning management establishment fees shall decrease for license year 2015 as follows:

- Initial application and annual license fee base fee decreases \$4.03 from \$167.72 to \$163.69.
- Poundage fee decreases \$0.11 from \$4.62 to \$4.51.

Radiation Machine Registration Fees and Mammography Authorization Fees

As stipulated under **MCL 333.13522**, the following adjustments should be made effective October 1, 2014 to the fees:

- Nondental, nonveterinary x-ray tube:
Per tube fee: \$3.02 decrease from \$125.64 to \$122.62.
- Dental or veterinary x-ray tube
First tube fee: \$1.81 decrease from \$75.36 to \$73.55
Each additional tube fee \$1.00 decrease from \$41.80 to \$40.80

In connection with mammography authorization (per radiation machine)

- Inspection fee: \$4.02 decrease from \$167.56 to \$163.54
- Reinspection for re-instatement: \$4.02 decrease from \$167.56 to \$163.54
- Evaluation for compliance: \$27.03 decrease from \$1,126.16 to \$1,099.13
- Reevaluation due to failure during previous evaluation: \$ 11.58 decrease from \$482.56 to \$470.98
