SUBJECT:

Public Health Code Fees Annual Adjustments for Change in Detroit CPI

Three sections of the Public Health Code require for fee changes based on amounts determined by the State Treasurer to reflect annual percent changes in the Detroit CPI. [The sections are: 333.5431(4), 333.13306(4), and 333.13522(8)]. In addition, MCL 289.3119(6) of the Food Law uses the June-June percentage change in the Detroit CPI for adjusting fees.

The percentage change from June 2015 to June 2016 in the Detroit All-Items CPI-U is +2.3 percent.

Newborn Screening Fee

As stipulated in MCL 333.5431(4): To reflect the 2.3 percent increase in the Detroit CPI between June 2015 and June 2016, the newborn screening fee may be increased by no more than \$2.81 from \$122.35 to \$125.16 on October 1, 2016. Please note that the newborn screening fee may be increased as recommended by the Newborn Screening Quality Advisory Committee and approved by the legislature to cover the cost of new screening requirements.

In addition, as provided under MCL 333.5430, the fee may also be adjusted to account for changes in conditions covered and screening procedures as recommended by the newborn screening quality assurance advisory committee subject to the approval of the Department of Community Health and the legislature.

Dry Cleaning License Fees

As stipulated under MCL 333.13306, dry cleaning management establishment fees shall increase for license year 2017 as follows:

- Initial application and annual license fee base fee increases \$3.76 from \$163.69 to \$167.45.
- Poundage fee increases \$0.10 from \$4.51 to \$4.61.

Radiation Machine Registration Fees and Mammography Authorization Fees

As stipulated under MCL 333.13522, the following adjustments should be made effective October 1, 2016 to the fees:

• Nondental, nonveterinary x-ray tube:

Per tube fee:

\$2.82 increase from \$122.62 to \$125.44.

• Dental or veterinary x-ray tube

First tube fee:

\$1.69 increase from \$73.55 to \$75.24

Each additional tube fee

\$0.94 increase from \$40.80 to \$41.74

In connection with mammography authorization (per radiation machine)

• Inspection fee:

\$3.76 increase from \$163.54 to \$167.30

• Reinspection for re-instatement:

\$3.76 increase from \$163.54 to

\$167.30

- Evaluation for compliance: \$25.28 increase from \$1,099.13 to \$1,124.41
- Reevaluation due to failure during previous evaluation: \$10.83 increase from \$470.98 to \$481.81

SUBJECT:

Change in Detroit CPI for Public Health Code Annual Fee Adjustment

Attached is a memo for your signature regarding the required annual adjustments to the Public Health Code Annual Fees by the change in the Detroit CPI. The June 2015 Detroit all items CPI was 219.034. The June 2016 Detroit all items CPI was 224.070. Thus, as the attached memo indicates, the June 2015-June 2016 percentage CPI change is +2.3 percent.

Three sections of the Public Health Code allow for fee changes based on amounts determined by the State Treasurer to reflect annual changes in the Detroit CPI. The sections are:

- MCL 333.5431(4). Newborn screening fee. Please note that, in addition to adjustments made under MLC 333.5431, the screening fee may also be adjusted under MCL 333.5430 by the newborn screening quality assurance advisory committee subject to the approval of the Department of Community Health and legislature.
- MCL 333.13306(4). Class IV dry cleaning license fees.
- MCL 333.13522(8). License fees for radiation and devices and equipment.

In addition, MCL 289.3119(6) of the Food Law uses the June-June percentage change in the Detroit CPI for adjusting fees.

The memo provides allowable percent increases in the fees as well as permissible dollar amount increases for the three Public Health Code MCL cites.
