**FY 2016  
County Revenue Sharing Reserve Fund  
Allowable Spending Amounts**

Below is a listing of the amounts each county may spend from their Revenue Sharing Reserve Fund during the county's 2016 Fiscal Year. This amount shall be included in the county's Fiscal Year 2016 revenue. All amounts are final.

The allowable spending amounts for Fiscal Year 2016 are calculated by growing the allowable spending amounts for Fiscal Year 2015 by the rate of inflation between the State's 2014 and 2015 Fiscal Years. The inflation rate is calculated using the U.S. Consumer Price Index (CPI-U). The inflation rate used for Fiscal Year 2016 is 0.3%.
