If you wish to protest in writing, complete Form UIA 1471T, *Protest of a Determination*. This form is located on the UI website under the Forms link. Include your name and employer account number (EAN) on documents submitted with your protest. Mail the completed Form UIA 1471T and any supporting documents to Unemployment Insurance, P.O. Box 8068, Royal Oak, MI 48068-8068 or by fax to 517-635-0014. Your protest must be signed.

## **Appeal Rights**

Box 8068, Royal Oak, MI 48068-8068 or by fax to 517-635-0014. Your appeal must be signed.
