**Background:** The WIA P-MIG has existed in a Microsoft Word format and has previously been updated via a Policy Issuance. User survey responses shared a desire to:

- a) update the document to an electronic format, and
- b) have the P-MIG updated immediately upon changes to OSMIS.

WDA is working with the Department of Technology, Management and Budget (DTMB) to create a long-term solution where P-MIG data is available within the One-Stop Management Information System (OSMIS). One step in that process is creating a “data field-to-description” structure,

which is not feasible in the current Word format. As an interim solution, electronic P-MIGs have been created (E-P-MIG).

**Policy:**

Effective immediately, the WIA Adult/Dislocated Worker (DW) E-P-MIG and the WIA Youth E-P-MIG are the WDA's official guides for WIA within the OSMIS. The P-MIG in Word format will no longer be updated or distributed.

Future changes to OSMIS screens affecting WIA will have a corresponding update to the E-P-MIGs prior to implementation; thus, the E-P-MIGs will remain current.

All OSMIS screen changes affecting WIA will continue to be announced via a System Update Notice. In addition, any new updates to the E-P-MIGs will be referenced, by date, in the "Change Tracking" tab within the E-P-MIGs. Future updates to the E-P-MIGs will not require a Policy Issuance; however, a Policy Issuance may be required unrelated to an E-P-MIG itself.

Access to the E-P-MIGs is available from the OSMIS link on the main entry screen, and is shown on Attachment A.

With the rescission of the WIA P-MIG PI 09-34, WIA forms and information unrelated to the E-P-MIGs will be located in WIA policy and/or a separate WIA Manual, to be distributed in the near future.
