Michigan Employment Security Act

Wagner-Peyser (WP) Act of 1933, as amended by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014

Background: The MWAs received funding in the amount of \$830,760 to provide RESEA activities to Unemployment Insurance claimants. This program replaces the mandatory profiling requirements. The goal of this program is to provide customized services to claimants deemed most likely to exhaust their Unemployment Insurance benefits.

Policy: This policy change extends the funding for this program to September 30, 2016.

Action: **Allocations and Funding**

Great Lakes Bay Michigan Works! and Southeast Michigan Community Alliance (SEMCA) Michigan Works! will submit a Budget Information Summary with a new ending date of September 30, 2016, within 5 days of the issuance of this policy by email to [Welfare Reform/Wagner-Peyser](mailto:Welfare Reform/Wagner-Peyser@wda-wr-wp@michigan.gov) (WDA-WR-WP@michigan.gov).
