Michigan Employment Security Act

Wagner-Peyser Act of 1933, as amended by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014

Background: The MWAs received funding in the amount of \$830,760 to provide RESEA activities to Unemployment Insurance claimants. This program replaces the mandatory profiling requirements. The goal of this program is to provide customized services to claimants deemed most likely to exhaust their Unemployment Insurance benefits.

Policy: This policy modification causes the policy to expire on September 30, 2016.

Action: No further action is required.

All other requirements from PI: 15-22, dated September 21, 2015, and subsequent changes, remain in effect.

Expiration Date: September 30, 2016
