**Background:** This policy redistributes FY 2017 TANF and General Fund/General Purpose  
(GF/GP) funding and extends the end-date of the program until  
December 31, 2017.

**Policy:** The Michigan Talent Investment Agency (TIA) will redistribute FY 2017  
GF/GP funding in the amount of \$120,000 allocated to Northwest Michigan.  
In addition, West Central and Upward Talent Council has de-obligated a total  
of \$125,000 of FY 2017 TANF funding which will be allocated to  
Berrien/Cass/Van Buren and Northwest. Berrien/Cass/Van Buren will also  
receive \$580,174 in FY 2017 TANF funding that was distributed because of  
unspent state-level TANF administrative funding. This policy also extends  
the end date of the FY 2017 TANF funding to December 31, 2017, in

accordance with the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services agreement for fifth quarter spending.

**Action:** All other requirements of PI 16-16 and Change 1 and 2 remain in effect. No action is necessary as all Budget Information Summaries required have been submitted and processed.
