Background: The federal Wagner-Peyser Act of 1933 provides for the establishment of a nationwide labor exchange system with ES offices that provide job matching at no cost to all employers and jobseekers, known as the Employment Service. The Wagner-Peyser Act was amended by the WIOA in 2014, which calls for stronger partnerships with ES to seek new avenues to enhance the seamless delivery of services in the One-Stop system.

ES focuses on a variety of employment-related labor exchange services including:

- Job search assistance.
- Assessments.
- Job referrals.
- Placement of jobseekers.
- Re-employment services to Unemployment Insurance (UI) claimants.
- Registering UI claimants for work.
- Delivery of the UI Work Test.
- Recruitment services for employers.

Policy: This policy change allocates an additional \$3,000,000 of Wagner-Peyser 7(a) funding to the MWAs in order to continue to provide a variety of employment-related labor exchange services.

All other requirements from PI 17-19, issued September 11, 2017, remain unchanged and in effect.

Action: The MWA officials shall prepare and submit a revised Budget Information Summary using the allocations listed in the allocation table. A template is attached.

This document must be submitted electronically to Ms. Teresa Keyton at keytont@michigan.gov within 30 days of the issuance of this policy.

Section I - Identification Information

Michigan Works! Agency (MWA) Name: Enter the name of the MWA.

Section II - Total Funds Available

Beginning Allocation: Enter the amount of the original allocation.

Section III - Planned Expenditures by Cost Categories

Administration: Enter the amount of funding to support MWA administration (20 percent limitation on allocation).

Program: Enter the amount of funding to support programmatic costs.

Total Planned Expenditures: This cell will automatically calculate the sum of Section III.

Section IV – Limitation Percentage

Planned Administration Expenditures (Must be Equal to or Less Than 20 percent): This cell will automatically calculate the percentage of planned administration expenditures in comparison to total funds available.
