Background: The Unemployment Insurance Agency (UIA) is a required partner in the comprehensive, integrated workforce system. Individuals who have lost employment due to lack of suitable work and have earned sufficient wage credits may receive unemployment insurance (UI) benefits if they meet initial and continuing eligibility requirements. Since 2005, the United States Department of Labor (USDOL) and participating state UIAs have been addressing individual reemployment needs of the UI claimants to prevent and detect improper UI payments. This program has replaced the Mandatory Profiling program. The UIA submitted a proposal, developed by the UIA and the Michigan Talent Investment Agency/Workforce Development Agency (TIA/WDA), to the USDOL to continue the RESEA program.

Policy: This policy change awards the MWAs an additional \$1,127,457 to continue the delivery of RESEA services to the claimants deemed most likely to exhaust their UI benefits.

All other provisions of PI 18-26 not specifically altered by this policy change remain unchanged and in effect.

Action: The MWAs must complete a Budget Information Summary (BIS) using the allocations listed in the Attachment.

The revised BIS must be submitted electronically to the WDA at TED-TSDIV@michigan.gov within 30 days of the issuance of this policy.
