In compliance with the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification ("WARN") Act, this is to notify you that due to a loss of customer business Avancez, LLC plans to implement a Mass Layoff at its facility located at 27767 George Merrelli Drive Warren, Michigan 48092.

The Mass Layoffs are expected to begin on December 2, 2016. We expect the layoffs to be permanent, but will not close the entire facility.

Enclosed for your information is a copy of a notice being distributed today to employees of Avancez (or their representative, as required), notifying them of their layoff date.

Greater advance notice was not given because of the unforeseeable business circumstances provision in WARN Act, due to FCA unexpected decision to buildout production earlier. That decision was completely outside of Avancez's control.

Except for hourly bargaining unit team members whose bumping rights are governed by seniority provisions contained in the bargaining agreement, team members do not have bumping rights. The plant's hourly bargaining unit team members are represented by UAW Local 155. The local representative contact information and address of this union is Duana King, Local 155 President, 7420 Murthum Avenue, Warren, MI 48092.

Additionally, enclosed in this letter is a list of job titles of positions affected, and the number of affected employees in each job classification. (See Exhibit A).
