NOTICE OF BUSINESS CLOSING - WARN ACT NOTICE

Dear Members of the Dislocated Worker Unit:

Burtek Enterprises, Inc. ("Burtek") will be permanently closing its business operations located at 50325 Patricia St., Chesterfield, Michigan. The closure has been prompted by the business landscape for the Company's products and services.

This action is expected to result in the permanent elimination of 108 employees – 30 salary and 78 hourly positions. The Company expects to begin eliminating positions on December 31, 2016 and will continue in phases until complete closure on February 28, 2017. Because the job losses will be permanent, no bumping rights will exist.

The employees are not represented by a union. Attached is a list of job functions, number of employees impacted within each job function and the anticipated layoff date for salaried and hourly workers. Please note that it is not possible to predict with certainty when employees will be ultimately affected or the exact order in which individual employees will be separated.

The Company will attempt to pay employees all earned wages and benefits at the time of their termination.
