Subject: Warn Act Notice

To Whom This May Concern:

Please be advised that this communication is being provided pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act. This letter is to advise you that a "mass layoff" as defined by the Act will take place at Ford Motor Company – Flat Rock Assembly Plant located at 1 International Dr., Flat Rock MI 48134.

It is anticipated that approximately **1012** hourly and salaried employees will be affected by the "mass layoff" on or about April 1, 2019. This "mass layoff" will be considered indefinite.

The number of employees by classification outlined in this letter may be less due to the experience of potential attrition, e.g. voluntary quits, retirements, transfers, etc. between now and the effective dates on these actions.

The following are the classification and the number of affected employees presently occupying these classifications:
