

WHERE CAN EXAMPLES OF WETLANDS BE SEEN?

Listed below are some places where the different types of wetlands can be found in Michigan. Remember that wetland habitats are fragile and easily damaged by human activity. It is best to visit them in small groups, and to avoid wading through areas of soft muck soils and shallows where sensitive plants may occur. Many of the areas listed in the table below have boardwalks traversing the wetlands or observation towers to improve access, and to reduce human impact.
