The Office of Retirement Services administers retirement programs for Michigan's state employees, public school employees, judges, state police, and National Guard members. Within these systems, ORS administers defined benefit pension plans, defined benefit retiree healthcare plans, and defined contribution plans. Each system is promulgated in State statutes and has a Retirement Board which provides oversight and general policy guidance.
