POLICY 1650.00 Accessibility and Reasonable Accommodations & Modifications

Executive Branch Departments, Agencies, and Sub-units (collectively, “Departments”) shall comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990, as amended; Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended; the Michigan Deaf Persons’ Interpreters Act, 1982 PA 204, MCL 393.501 *et seq.*; and the Michigan Persons with Disabilities Civil Rights Act, 1976 PA 220, MCL 37.1101 *et seq.* (collectively, the “Acts”) to ensure that printed materials and documents, meetings and events, videos and other media production, social media, websites, applications, and electronic documents are accessible to persons with disabilities as required by law.
