POLICY 0240 Emergencies/Disasters

Issued: January 1, 1994
Revised: September 6, 2024

Executive Branch Departments and Sub-units shall request assistance from 911 for medical emergencies, fires, and acts of violence. Executive Branch Departments and Sub-units operating within DTMB-managed facilities shall request assistance from the Department of Technology, Management and Budget (DTMB), Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Protection (CIP), Office of Infrastructure Protection (OIP) regarding hazardous material emergencies, bomb threats, natural disasters, suspicious activity, and suspicious items.

The Michigan State Police, Emergency Management & Homeland Security Division will coordinate the response of all Executive Branch Departments and Sub-units in statewide emergency and/or disaster situations.
