

POLICY 2220 Occupational Safety and Health

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Executive Branch Departments and Sub-units shall protect the safety and health of employees by requesting education and training assistance on occupational safety and health issues, and on-site consultation services in evaluation of their safety and health management systems; complying with applicable statutory and regulatory requirements; and reporting occupational diseases to the Michigan Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity (LEO).
