CONTRACT PRE-APPROVALS

1. **HIGHWAYS - Development Studies and Environmental Assessment**
Contract (2024-0633) between MDOT and Colliers Engineering & Design, Architecture, Landscape Architecture, Surveying, CT P.C., will provide for design services to be performed for two phase project development studies and environmental assessment on M-85 at the Grand Trunk Railroad grade crossing just north of Van Horn Road in the City of Trenton, Wayne County. The work items will include public involvement/stakeholder engagement; analysis of transportation/operational, noise, air quality, and hazardous material; prepare NEPA environmental assessment. The contract will be in effect from the date of award through March 27, 2028. The contract amount will not exceed 110 percent of the engineer’s estimate of \$2,088,236.99. Source of Funds: 90% Federal Highway Administration Funds and 10% State Restricted Trunkline Funds.

2. **HIGHWAYS - Construction Services**
Contract (2024-0836): MDOT will enter into a contract with a consultant that will provide for full construction engineering services to be performed for freeway sign upgrades and the installation of delineators on US-23 and M-14 in the Cities of Ann Arbor and Milan and in the Village of Dundee in Livingston, Monroe, and Washtenaw Counties. The work items will include project administration; inspection; staking; quality assurance testing and reporting; measurement, computation, and documentation of quantities; reporting and record-keeping; and finalizing project documentation. The contract will be in effect from the date of award through 34 months. The contract amount will not exceed 110 percent of the engineer’s estimate of \$664,367.65. Source of Funds: 100% Federal Highway Administration Funds.

3. **HIGHWAYS - Construction Services**
Contract (2024-0837): MDOT will enter into a contract with a consultant that will provide for full construction engineering services to be performed for the reconstruction of mainline pavement, culvert replacement, the rehabilitation of welcome center pavement, bridge deck replacements, substructure patching, and other improvements on I-75 from Otter Creek Road to LaPlaisance in LaSalle and Monroe Township in Monroe County. The work items will include project administration; inspection; staking; quality assurance

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testing and reporting; measurement, computation, and documentation of quantities; reporting and record-keeping; and finalizing all project documentation. The contract will be in effect from the date of award through six years. The contract amount will not exceed 110 percent of the engineer's estimate of \$11,226,725.20. Source of Funds: Federal Highway Administration Funds, State Restricted Trunkline Funds, and/or local funds, depending on the particular job number.

4. HIGHWAYS - Design Services

Contract (2024-0846) between MDOT and Fishbeck, Thompson, Carr & Huber, Inc., will provide for design services to be performed for the reconstruction and sewer separation of 1.5 miles of northbound M-3 from Wellington Crescent to Sandpiper Drive in the City of Mount Clemens and in Clinton Township, Macomb County. The work items will include performing design surveys; preparing required plans, typical cross-sections, details, and specifications; computing and verifying all plan quantities; utility coordination; and preparing staging plans and special provisions for maintaining traffic during construction. The contract will be in the effect from the date of the award through April 6, 2026. The contract amount will not exceed 110 percent of the engineer's estimate of \$1,150,197.82. Source of Funds: 81.85% Federal Highway Administration Funds and 18.15% State Restricted Trunkline Funds.

5. HIGHWAYS - Design Services

Contract (2025-0008) between MDOT and AECOM Great Lakes, Inc., will provide for engineering inspection of the Zilwaukee Bridge structures on I-75 northbound and southbound over the Saginaw River, M-13, and the Grand Trunk Western Railroad tracks and on the I-75 southbound ramp H over land for a raised ramp, Saginaw County. The work items will include inspection and reporting. The contract will be in effect from the date of award through June 1, 2026. The contract amount will not exceed 110 percent of the engineer's estimate of \$1,181,778.11. Source of Funds: 100% State Restricted Trunkline Funds.

6. HIGHWAYS - Construction Engineering

Contract (2025-0023) between MDOT and WSP Michigan, Inc., will provide for as-needed inspection, testing, engineering assistance, and surveying assistance services to be performed for construction projects at various locations in the Taylor Transportation Service Center service area in Wayne County. The work items will include inspection; quality assurance testing and reporting; measurement, computation, and documentation of quantities; and reporting and record-keeping. The contract will be in effect from the date of award through March 31, 2027. The contract amount will not exceed 110 percent of the engineer's estimate of \$5,952,730.93. Source of Funds: 81.85% Federal Highway Administration Funds and 18.15 State Restricted Trunkline Funds.

7. *AERONAUTICS - Advanced Aerial Mobility Technologies

Contract (2024-0828) between MDOT and Michigan Central Innovation District, LLC, will provide funding for the scaling of digital and physical infrastructure to expand the capabilities of the Advanced Aerial Mobility Region, a three-mile pilot zone for unmanned aerial system operations anchored at Michigan Central, and launch a series of pilot programs aimed at generating techno-economic data to accelerate the adoption of beyond visual line of sight (BVLOS) unmanned aerial system operations. The work items will include the undertaking of pilot programs for uses including building inspection,

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the movement of goods, and the movement of critical hospital supplies, and the validation of structures and data. The contract will be in effect from the date of award through May 30, 2026. The contract amount will be \$2,450,000. Source of Funds: 100% State Restricted Aeronautics Funds.

8. *AERONAUTICS - Advanced Aerial Mobility Technologies
Contract (2025-0029) between MDOT and Traverse Connect will provide funding for three projects intended to accelerate the development and deployment of Advanced Aerial Mobility (AAM) technologies and infrastructure within Northwestern Lower Michigan. The work items will include testing the use of drones to deliver medical supplies and support critical healthcare services; developing and testing AAM infrastructure, including drone ports and/or vertiports, to allow the use of drones for purposes including marine surveying, water sampling, bathymetric mapping, and emergency response support; and preparing and presenting a Water and Aerial Mobility Demonstration Day to validate the technical feasibility of using drone technology over water and within maritime space. The contract will be in effect from the date of award through May 1, 2026. The contract amount will be \$689,500. Source of Funds: 100% State Restricted Aeronautics Funds.
9. *EXECUTIVE (Office of Economic Development) - SR2S Program
Contract (2025-0006) between MDOT and the Michigan Fitness Foundation will support program development, project management, education and outreach, and technical assistance services for schools, communities, and partner agencies involved in the Federal Safe Routes to School (SR2S) Program. The contract will be in effect from the date of award through September 30, 2030. The contract amount will be \$13,406,014.22. Source of Funds: 100% Federal SR2S Program Funds.
10. *HIGHWAYS – Increase Services and Amount, Extend Term
Amendatory Contract (2023-0032/A2) between MDOT and Integral Blue, LLC, will increase the contract amount by \$13,456,269.69 and will extend the contract term by one year to provide for an additional year of the Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) infrastructure and network maintenance services. The original contract provides for ITS infrastructure and network maintenance services to be performed for all seven MDOT Regions and the Blue Water Bridge. The revised contract term will be from November 1, 2022, through October 31, 2025. The revised contract amount will be \$32,954,680.80. Source of Funds: Federal Highway Administration Funds and/or State Restricted Trunkline Funds, depending on the particular job number.
11. *RAIL - As-Needed Environmental Services
Contract (2025-0009) between MDOT and AECOM Great Lakes, Inc., will provide for as-needed environmental services to be performed to support MDOT projects on Michigan's state-owned rail lines. The services may include tasks related to reviewing reports, project descriptions, plans, or any other related documentation and will include subsurface investigation, soil borings, soil sampling, laboratory testing, and Threatened and Endangered Species surveys. The contract will be in effect from the date of award through three years. The maximum contract amount will be \$899,290, and the maximum amount of any work order will be \$899,290. Source of Funds: 100% State Restricted Comprehensive Transportation Funds.
