CASH BOND AND CONTACT INFORMATION FOR A SCRAP TIRE HAULER

(This information is required under the provisions of Part 169, Scrap Tires, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended. Providing false information may result in civil or criminal penalties.)

Those Scrap Tire Haulers that are subject to the requirements of Section 16905(6) of Part 169 may satisfy the financial assurance provisions of Part 169 by submitting a check or money order payable to the “State of Michigan,” and remit it to EGLE as follows:

- Send your Scrap Tire Hauler Registration Application and a check/money order payable to the “State of Michigan” in the amount of \$10,000 to the following:

Section 324.16905(6) of Part 169 establishes the amount of bond that a scrap tire hauler must maintain at \$10,000.
