

EGLE's Water Infrastructure Financing Section (WIFS), Remediation and Redevelopment Division (RDD), and Drinking Water and Environmental Health Division (DWEHD) have finalized prioritization of the C2R2 applications and have begun to reach out to communities in the fundable range to execute grant agreements. Applications were scored based on the criteria outlined in the C2R2 Grant Overview (michigan.gov). In the event of a tie in base scores, tiebreaker points were applied. Projects with zero base score points did not receive tie breaker scores given demand of funds outweighed availability of funds.

Some C2R2 grant agreements have already been issued and WIFS has been in contact with most applicants in the fundable ranges. For fundable applicants not yet contacted, WIFS staff will reach out as progress is made down the priority list until funding is exhausted. As applications are reviewed, grant amounts may change based on eligibility determinations, updated scope, etc. This process may result in changes to the fundable range and the potential for additional grant applications to become fundable. Should this situation occur, WIFS will reach out to the next applicant to discuss. Any proposed grant agreements greater than \$499,999 require State Administrative Board approval. This legislatively required step may add 3-4 weeks of processing time.

Contamination Priority List (approximately \$20 million). The dotted line marks the base of the fully fundable range (Rockford). Oscoda's request exceeds the remainder of the \$20 million available but could be partially fundable. In cases where applications received a base score of "0," tie-breaker points were not evaluated.
