**Propane Resilience Enhancement Program (Part B)**  
**Second Application Period**  
Section 510 (2)(a) of PA 119 of 2023

### **Instructions**

The Propane Resilience Enhancement Program (PREP) grant is a two-part program (Parts A and B). The overall goal is to ensure the adequacy of supply and affordability of pricing for residential and commercial consumers in Michigan who rely on propane as a primary energy source or as part of their preparedness and continuity plans.

Under Section 510 (2)(b) of PA 119 of 2023, the Michigan state legislature appropriated \$3.0 million to expand storage capacity connected to expanded propane pipeline and fractionation capacity. After the initial application phase, there is \$2,853,600 in available funding under Part B.

Applicants for **PREP Part B** grants should be propane fractionation, pipeline transport, or wholesale storage and distribution companies that are licensed to do business in Michigan<sup>1</sup> and are undertaking the project to enhance propane supply and resilience. The PREP Part B can cover material, labor, and equipment associated with the installation or rehabilitation of propane storage infrastructure. The program goal is for grantees to contribute at least 50% of projected project costs, however, applications proposing less than a 50% match are encouraged and will be considered in comparison to other applications received.

Applicants must not appear on the Federal Debarment and Suspension List and must be in good standing with EGLE programs (i.e. no EGLE grant revoked or terminated and no demonstrated inability to manage a grant or meet obligations in a project contract with EGLE).

### **Application Information**

Applicants must complete the following form and provide information on 1) applicant/project, 2) project workplan, 3) project details, and 4) applicable resilience enhancements. Additional information on the project may also be submitted as attachments if form area is inadequate.

Applicants must attach a project timeline and project budget, including itemized costs as well as vendor estimates/quotes (if available), in order to be considered for grant funding.

**Ranking/Scoring:** Projects will be ranked based on, grant amount requested, quality of the project, population/market impact, storage capacity increase, and resilience enhancements. Scores will be based on the criteria established in the [PREP Part B Overview Guidance Document](#).
