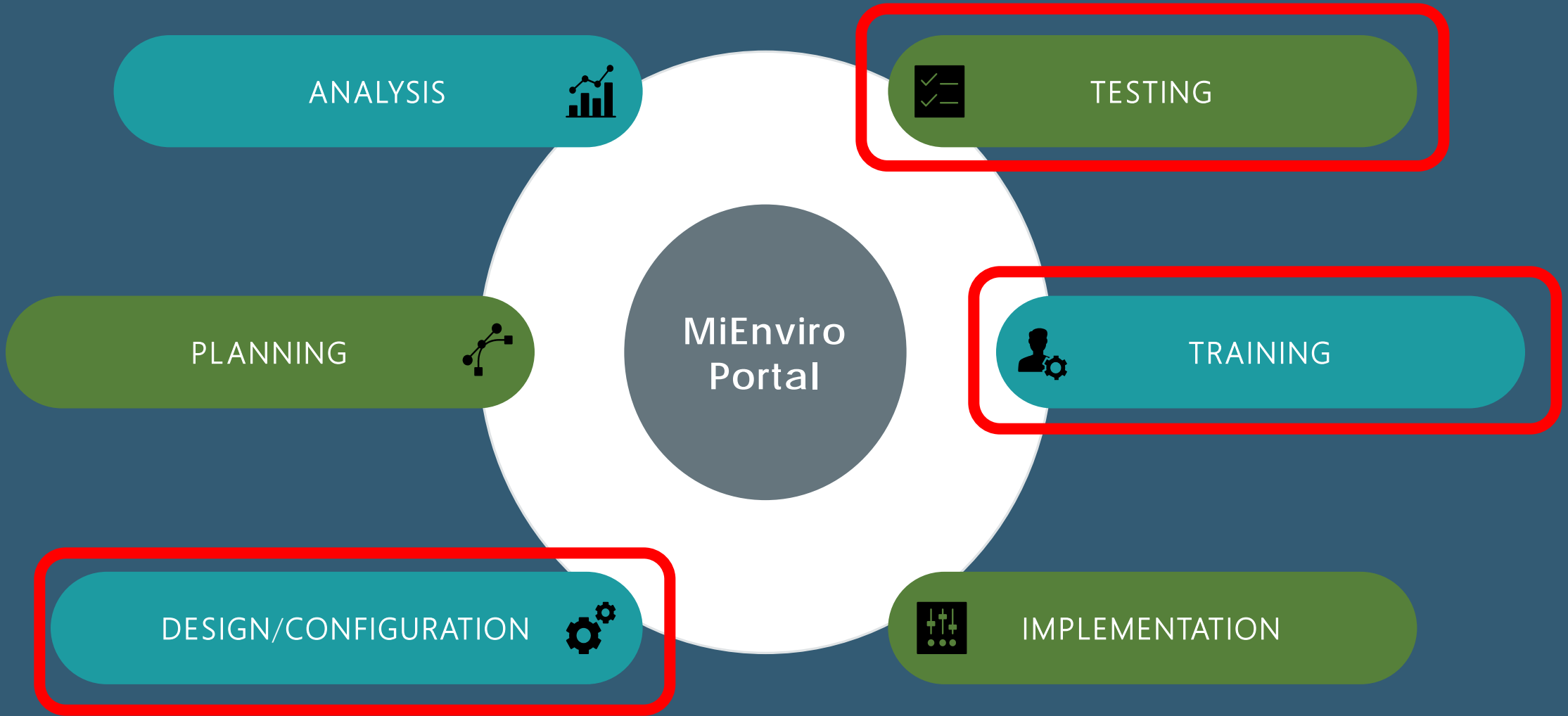
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Project Phases



Overall Implementation Schedule

Program Area Sequence	Go-Live Date
1. Dry Cleaning	December 16, 2022
2. SLEIS Data Reporting to EPA Emissions Inventory System	December 20, 2022
3. Asbestos	June 2023
4. Air Permitting, Compliance Reporting and Other	Late 2023-2024
5. SLEIS Emissions Reporting	January 2024

Implementation Schedule (cont.)

AQD Business Process:

- Dry Cleaning*

Dry Cleaning Implementation

- Live in December 2022
- Internal AQD users only (4 AQD program staff users)
- External users will be onboarded at a later date
- Inspections - mobile inspection tool
- Fee management
- Dry Cleaning License Generation
- Ongoing training and business process development

SLEIS (Emissions Reporting) Implementation

- First phase live in December 2022
- Facility and Point Inventories are submitted to the EPA Emissions Inventory System (EIS)
- Working to integrate Emissions Reporting and Permitting elements within MiEnviro
- Initial implementation of SLEIS for external users is proposed for late 2023 with emissions reporting beginning January 2024
- Ongoing development, configuration and testing

Asbestos Implementation

- Proposed implementation - June 2023
- Current EGLE Asbestos Notification System will be replaced
- MiEnviro will be used for demolition and renovation project notifications including those for MIOSHA
- New public tool for asbestos notification searching
- Ongoing configuration and testing

Remaining Air Implementation

- Proposed implementation – Late 2023/Early 2024
- Master Equipment Inventory
- Permit application submission
- Public Notice
- Compliance reporting
- Online complaint submission
- Ongoing configuration and testing

For registered users, MiEnviro Portal supports several types of actions:

- **Apply for permits**
- **Manage your permits (pay fees, apply for renewals)**
- **View issued permits**
- **Submit reports (required by your permit or certification)**
- **Submit compliance notifications**
- **Submit service requests (such as Wetland Identification or Floodplain services)**
- **See your email notifications**
- **Review evaluations / site inspections**

Submit Complaint of Pollution, Spills, or Unauthorized Activities
